### Admission Requirements

- BGCSE or equivalent with a minimum of 30 points with at least D in Biology, Chemistry, Physics or double science, Mathematics and English , OR
- 2 years relevant, current health work experience or a recommendation letter

The programme is a one (1) year full time course running over two (2) semesters. The program comprises of theory, practical's and field attachment over the twelve (12) month period.
